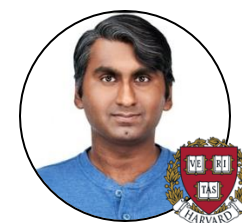

What is DePIN?

DePIN = Decentralized Physical Infrastructure Networks.

DePINs use crypto-incentives to efficiently coordinate the **buildout & operation of critical infrastructure** on top of public blockchains.

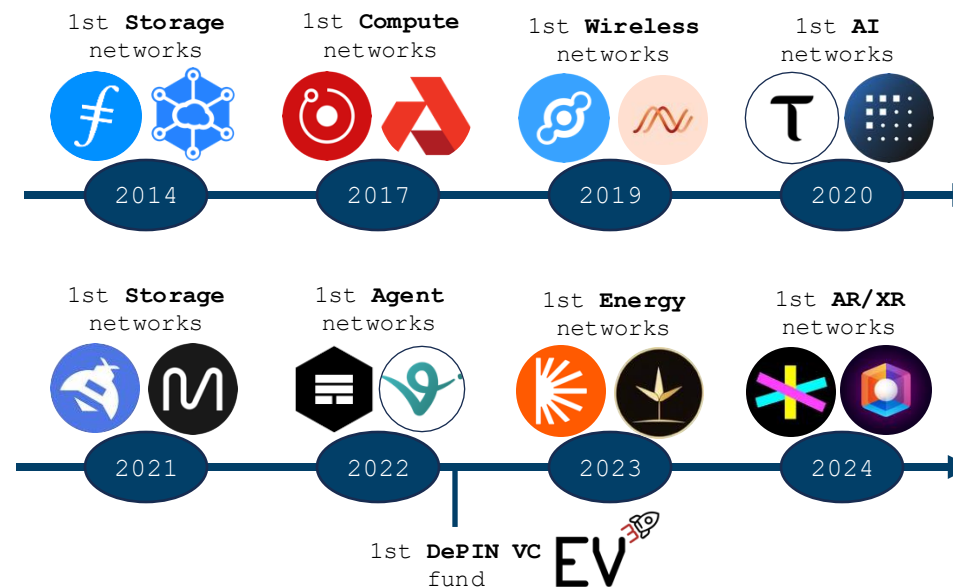

DePIN Timeline



DePIN empowers & incentivizes people to improve public infrastructure around them.

In a world full of untrustworthy institutions & incompetent bureaucrats, DePIN transfers wealth & power back to citizens & communities.

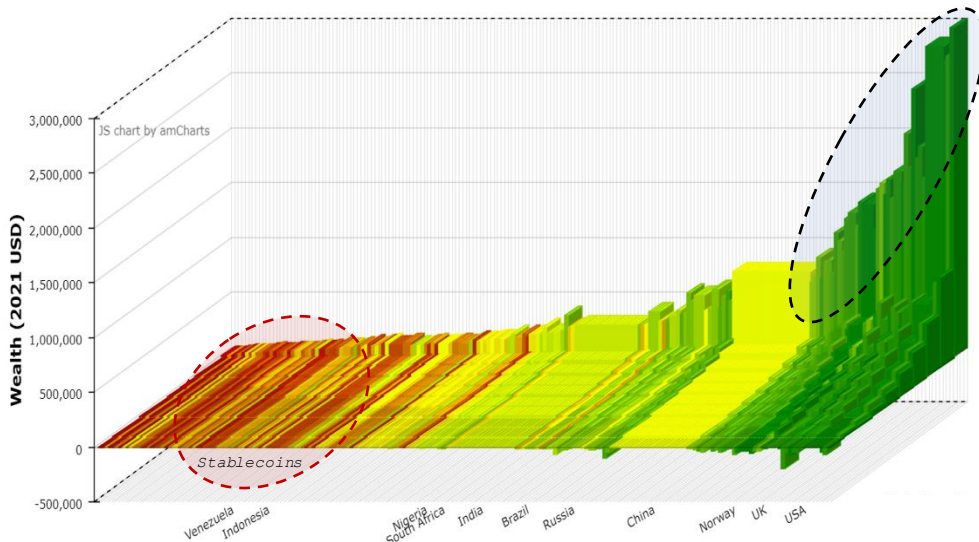


DePIN is how the majority of humanity will onboard onto the crypto economy.

The first 500 million crypto owners won the genetic lottery: they were lucky enough to *buy* their first crypto... **the next 5B crypto owners will *earn* their first crypto.**

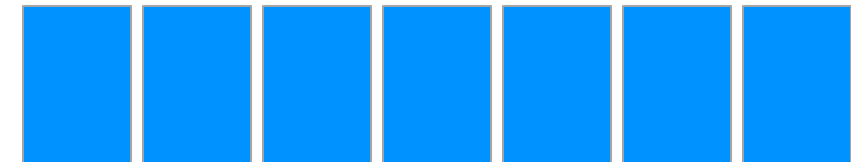
Wealth Distribution

To date, global crypto ownership (ex-stablecoins) has been concentrated in wealthy countries, where consumers have disposable income & a high-risk tolerance for their capital.

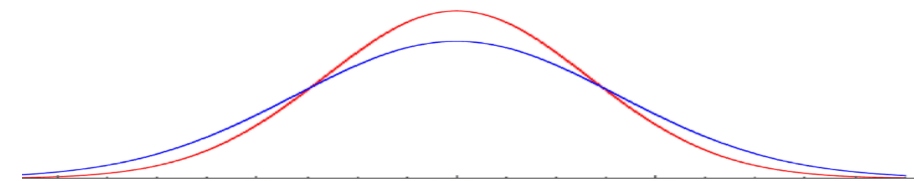


Capability Distribution

Unlike the massive power law in global wealth distribution, humans' time, intelligence and physical capabilities are either uniformly or normally distributed.



Time is uniformly distributed - everyone gets 24 hours per day.



Intelligence is ~normally distributed (IQ).

DePIN is AGI reaching back in time to create the resources it needs to thrive.

Generating a 5-second video today **costs >\$0.10 in compute, electricity & bandwidth**... advanced AIs will demand these digital commodities at an unimaginable scale.

What does it take to generate a 5-second video?

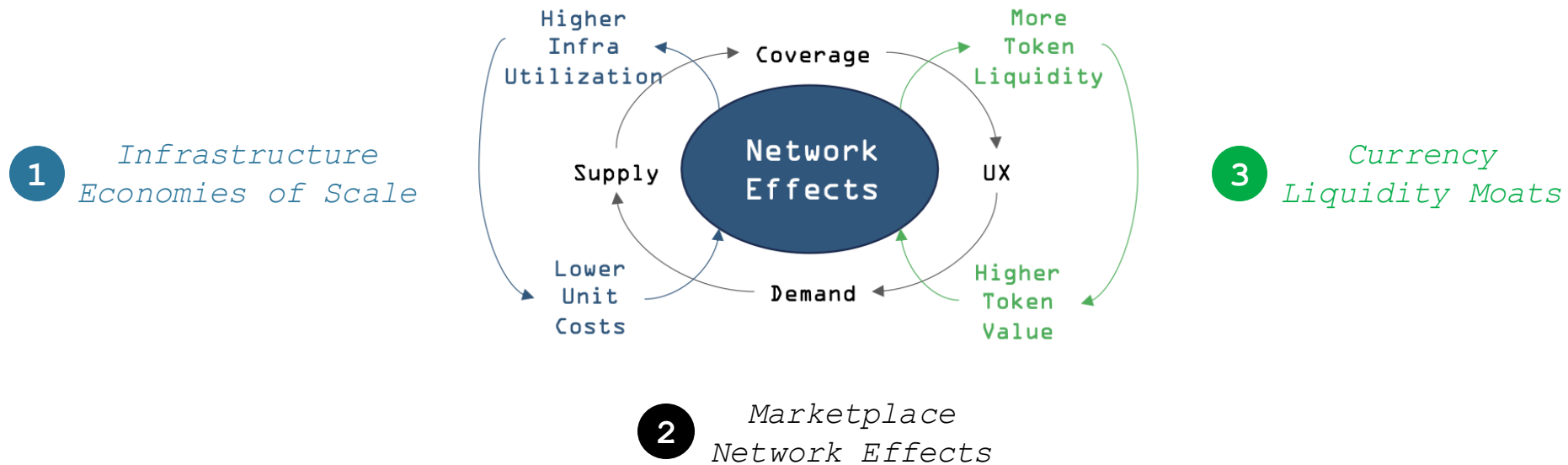

DePIN is the first triple-point business model capable of spawning \$10T+ networks.

DePIN Flywheels combine the economies of scale of traditional infrastructure (1), with the network effects of a tech platform (2), and the liquidity moats of a currency (3).

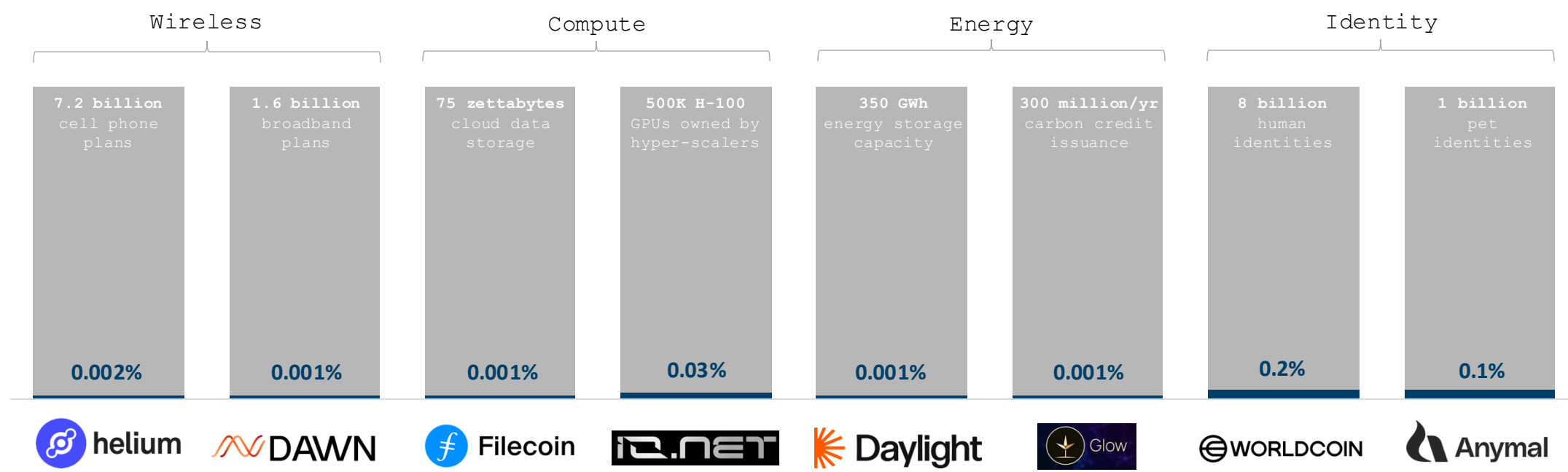

DePIN is in its earliest innings with <0.1% market share of \$1T+ end-markets.

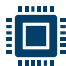










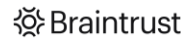






DePIN will grow 100-1000x over the next decade as networks win market share from centralized corporations with slower, less reliable and less dynamic offerings.

With \$50B of market cap across 350 tokens, the DePIN sector trades at ~100x ARR.

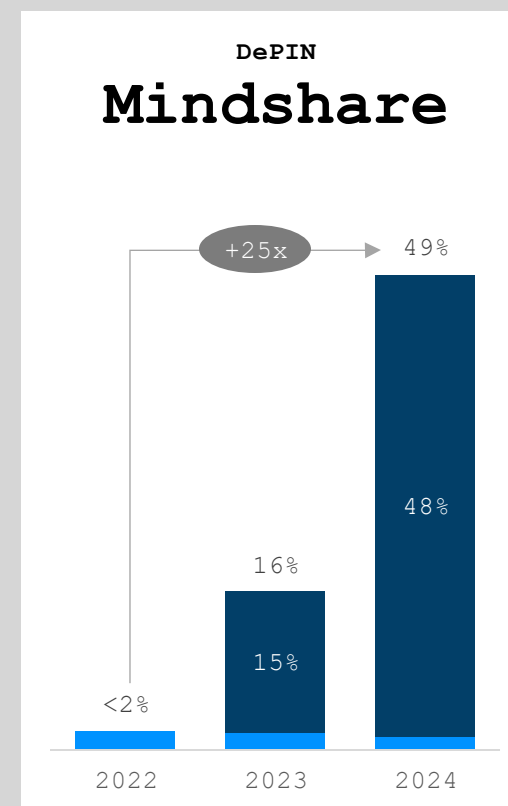
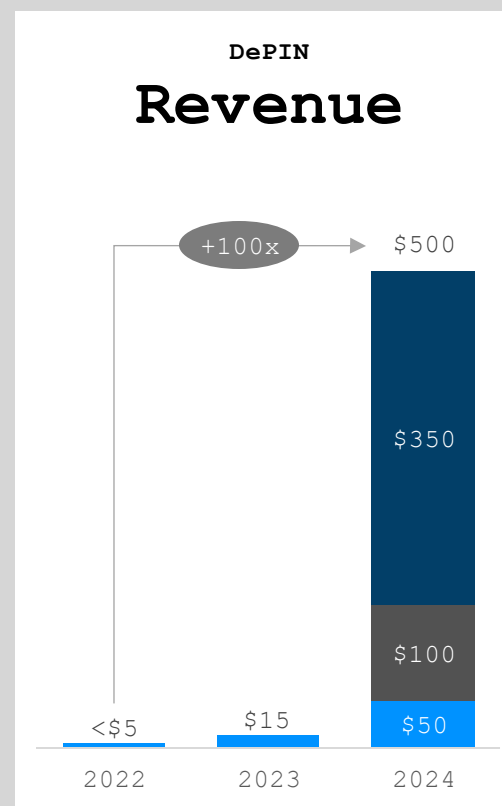
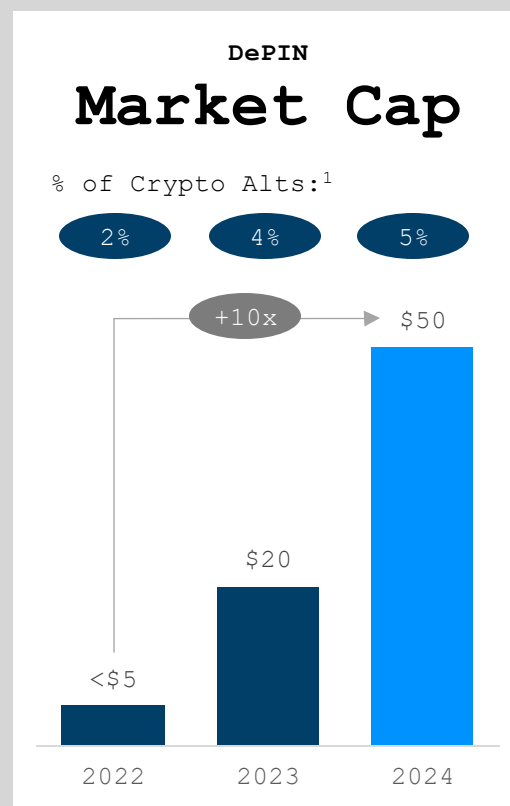
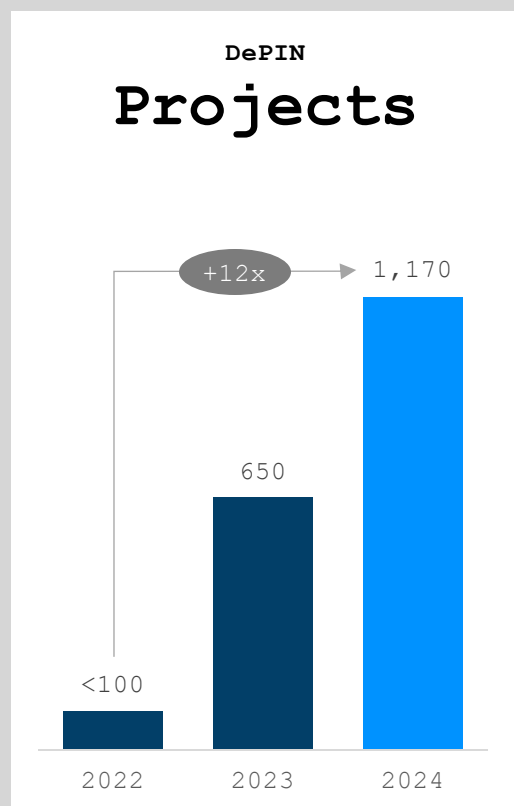

Scaling supply-side is no longer a mystery: clear growth playbooks have emerged.

Most DePINs combine **light nodes** for low onboarding friction & new user acquisition with **heavy nodes** for stronger and more reliable network performance.

Easier to onboard new nodes

Hosted Nodes

Users pay an up-front node license fee & earn mining rewards over time.

Centralization: users don't control their nodes.

Notable Examples



Browser Extensions

DePINs tap into browser resources like bandwidth and edge compute.

Low reliability: active tabs get prioritized first.

Notable Examples



Mobile Apps

DePINs tap into smartphone sensor data and computing resources.

Low flexibility: hamstrung by app store rules.

Notable Examples



Desktop Apps

DePINs tap into CPU/GPU/RAM & bandwidth from users' laptops.

Low conversion: users hesitant to run executables.

Dedicated Hardware

DePINs sell custom and/or off-the-shelf hardware devices to users.

Complexity: managing hardware supply chains.

Enterprise / Fleets

DePINs work with enterprise fleets to deploy devices at scale.

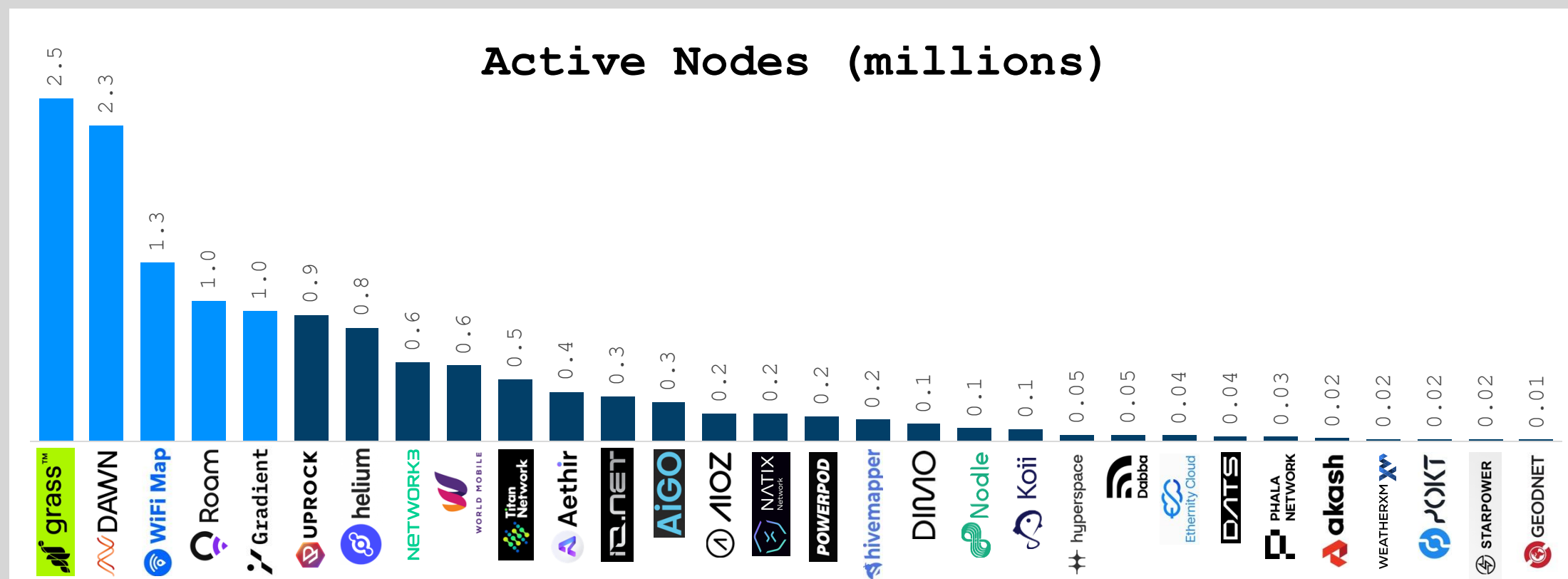


More powerful node capabilities

Trade-offs:

More than 13 million devices globally contribute to DePINs every single day.

Twenty DePINs grew to >100k active nodes in 2024, five of which are now above 1m nodes.



With supply-side proven out, DePIN faces a new set of challenges: demand & monetization.

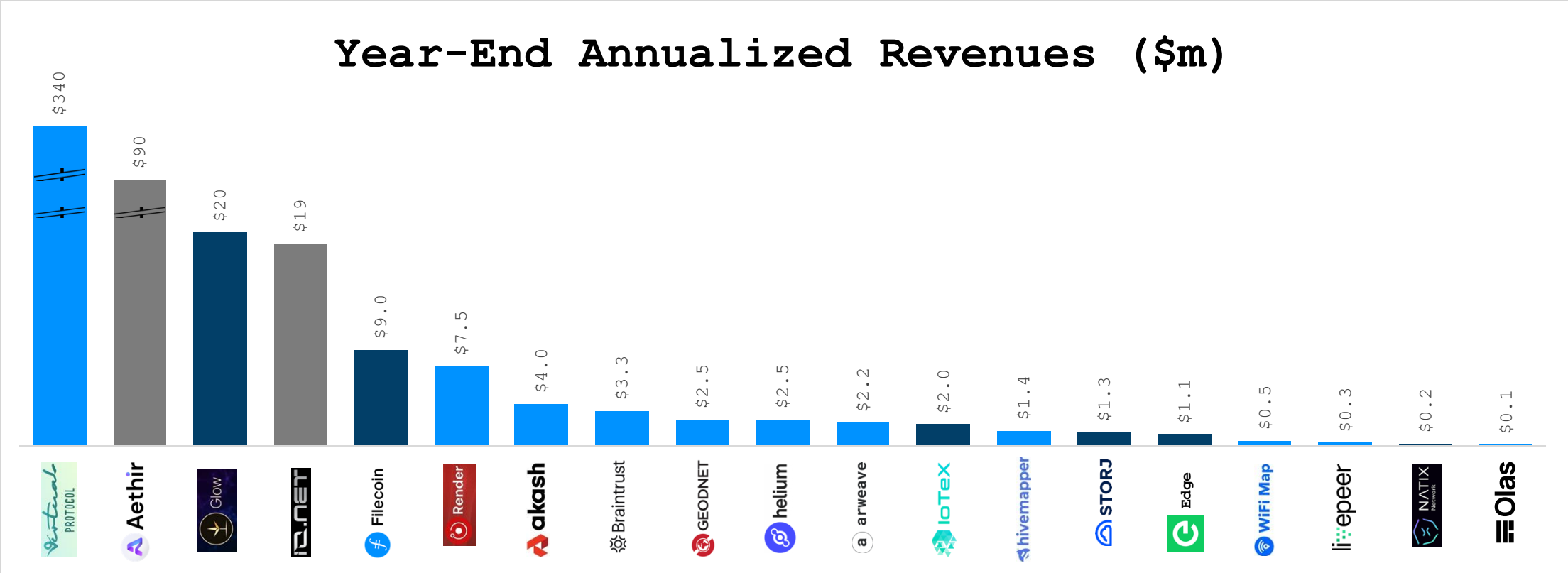

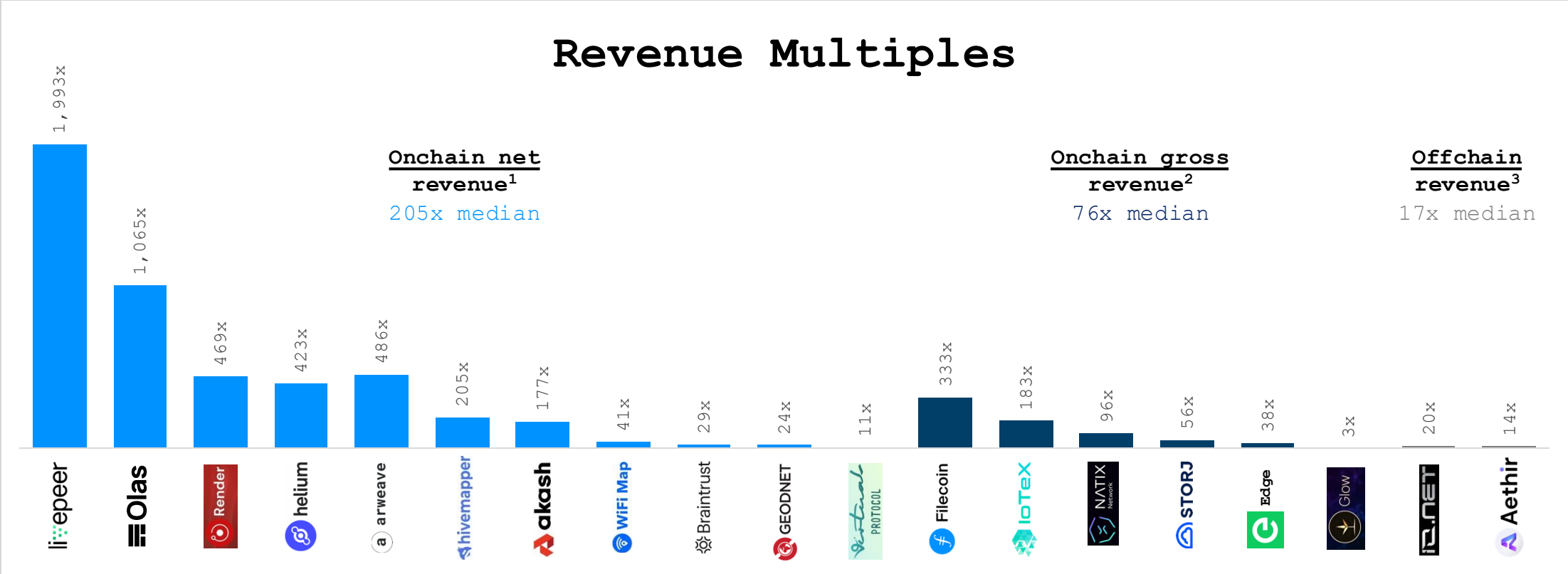
Total **DePIN revenues** grew **+33x** in 2024 (+3.3x including onchain net revenues only) invalidating bear market critics who claimed that "DePIN has no demand-side."

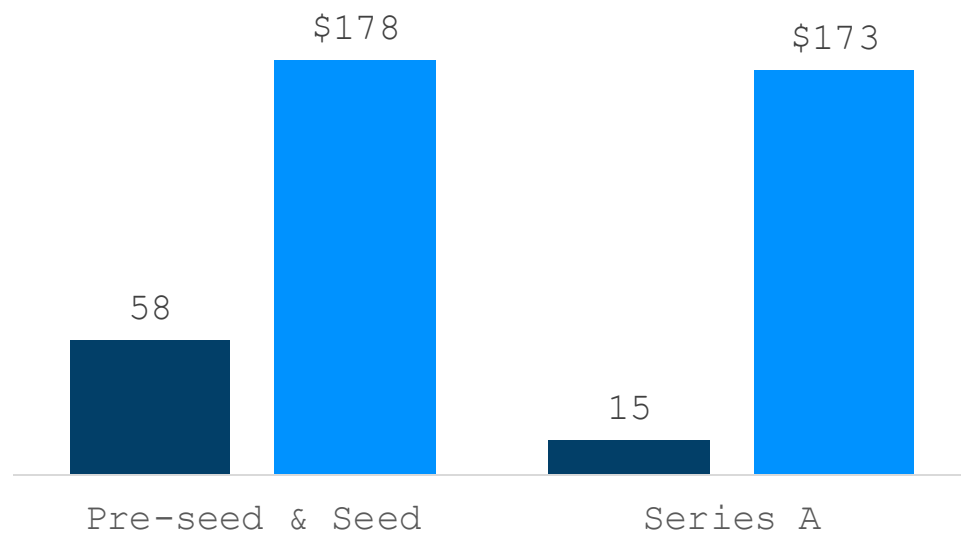

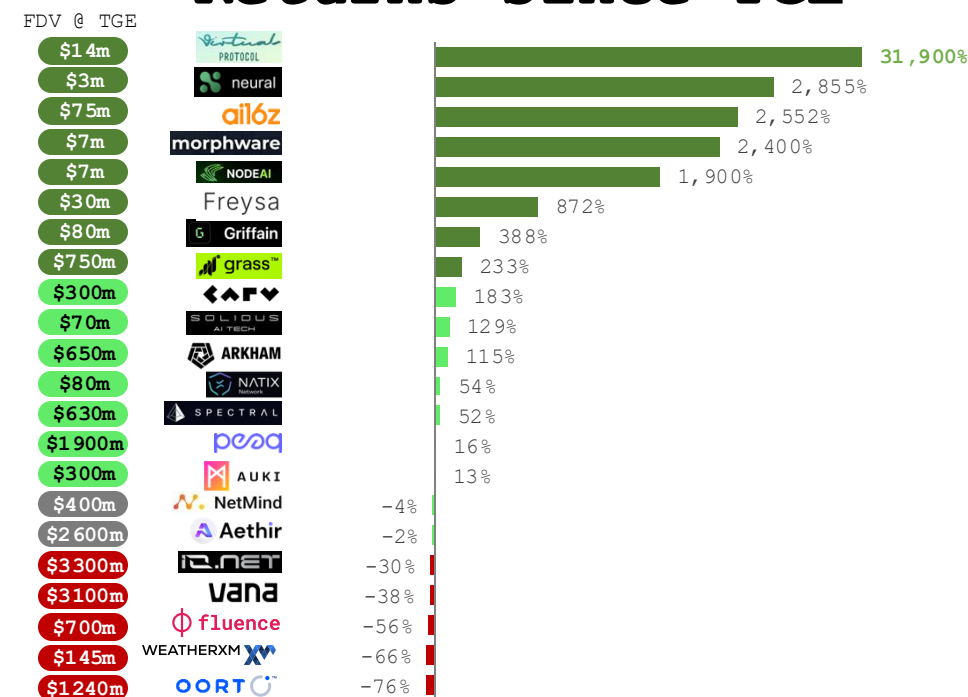
In private markets, more capital was raised at the pre-seed/seed stage than Series A; in liquid markets, a low listing FDV was the primary determinant of outsized returns.

A handful of thesis-driven VCs concentrated their bets on the biggest DePIN markets.

Multicoin, Framework, a16z Crypto and EV3 were among the highest-conviction backers of DePINs with 8+ investments in 2024 and \$100m+ raised by each of their DePIN portfolios.

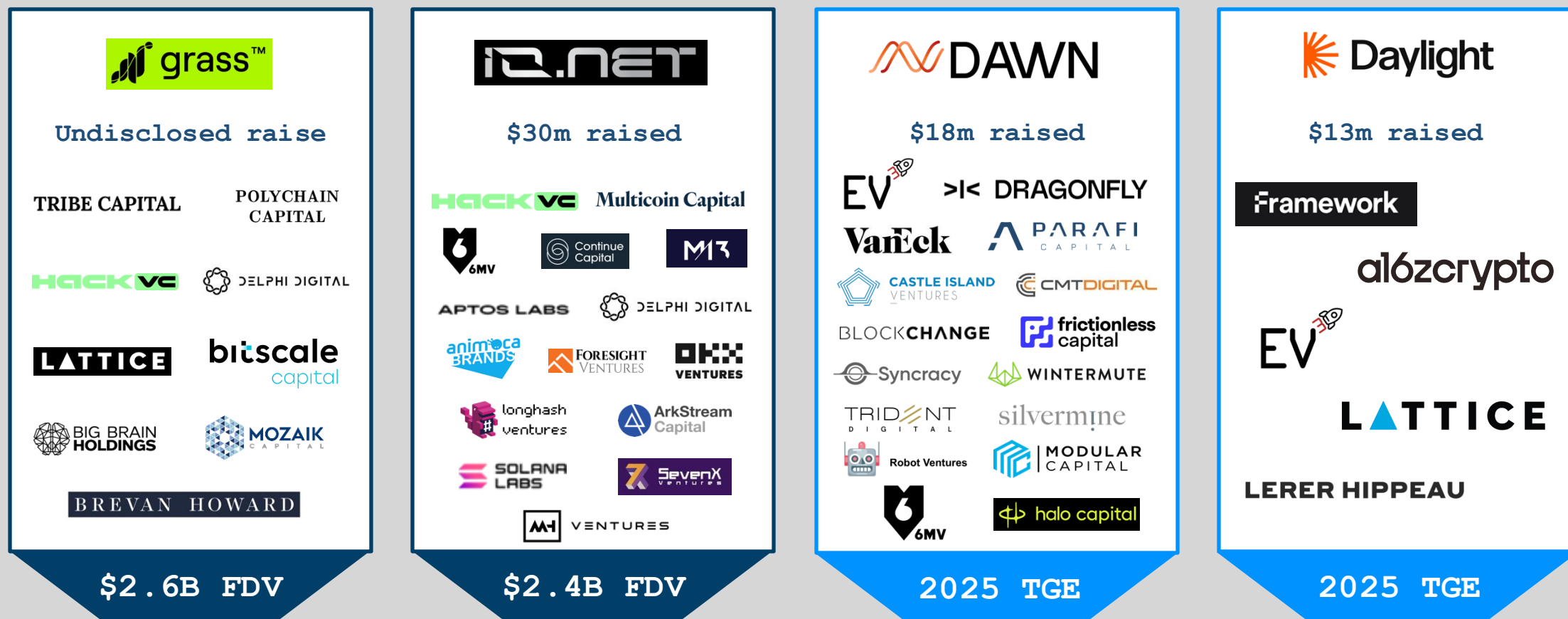

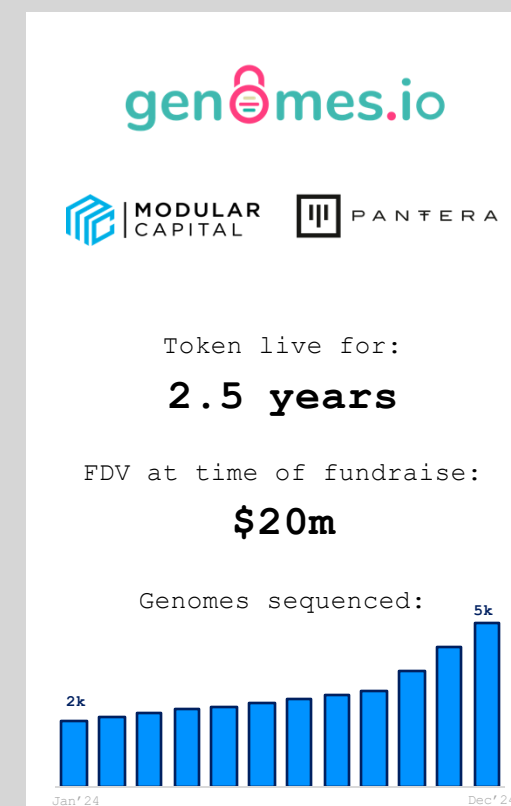
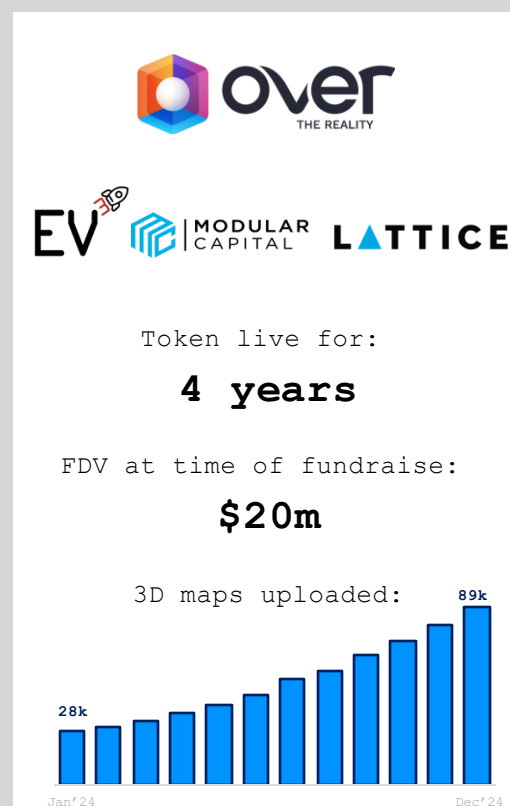
Most late-stage capital went to a few breakout DePINs backed by several top VCs.

DePINs that manage to raise eight figures of VC capital tend to launch tokens at around a **50-100x multiple of book value**, i.e. at multi-billion dollar FDVs.



DePINs with live tokens are skipping VCs & raising from crypto hedge funds instead.

Crypto hedge funds including **EV3 Liquids**, **Modular**, **Pantera** & **Borderless** provide growth capital & post-investment support to DePINs even after their TGE.








DePINs are raising capital directly from their communities alongside VC rounds.

DePINs raised >\$230m from their communities in 2024 through a combination of node sales, crowdfunding platforms & protocol-owned liquidity pools.

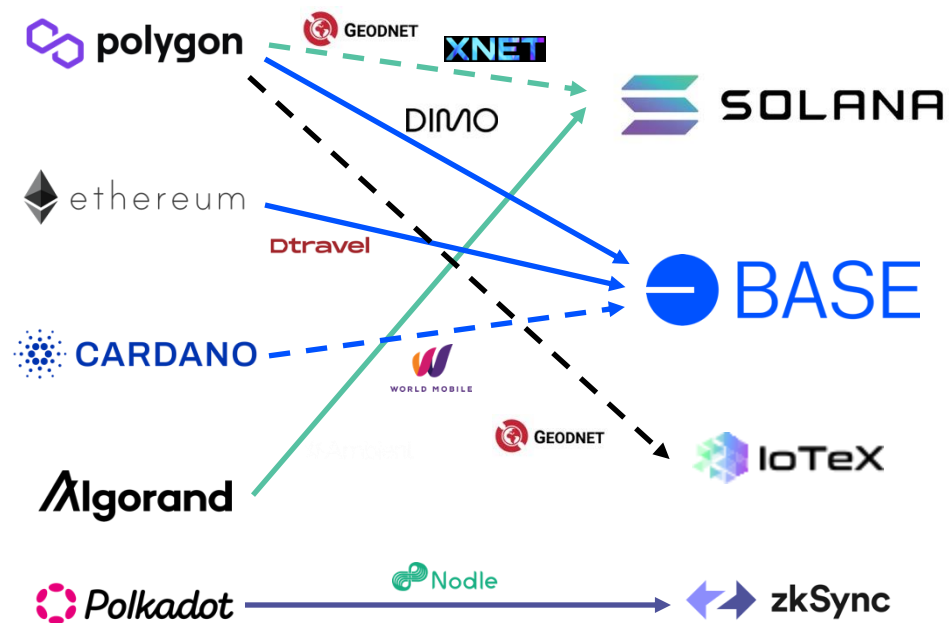

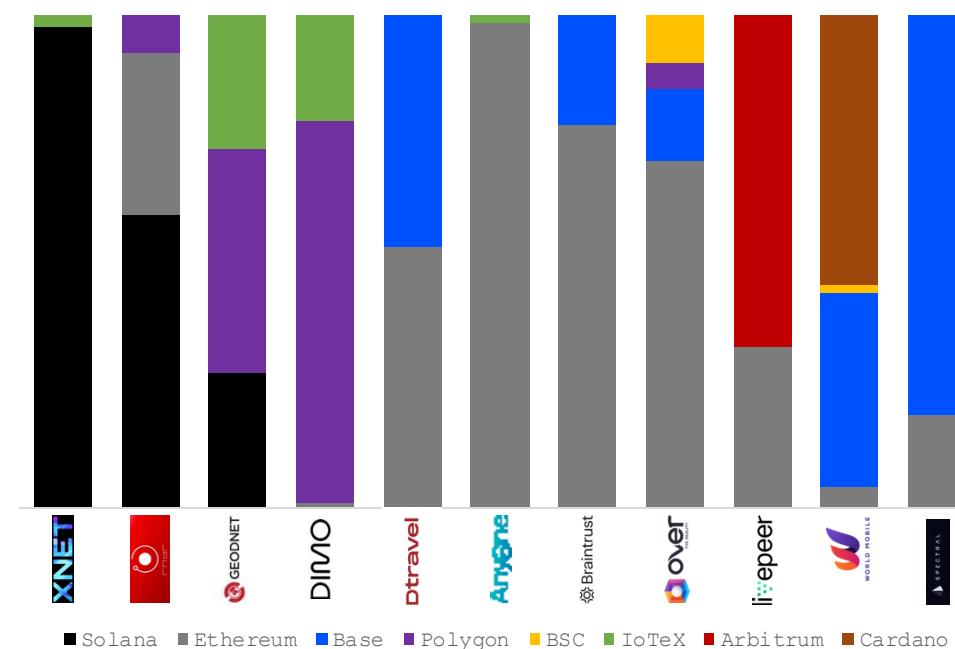
DePIN "chain wars" accelerated, with Solana & Base taking market share from other L1s.

Powered by interoperability solutions Wormhole & Layer Zero, many DePINs are going **multi-chain** to expand their user base, at the cost of fragmenting liquidity.

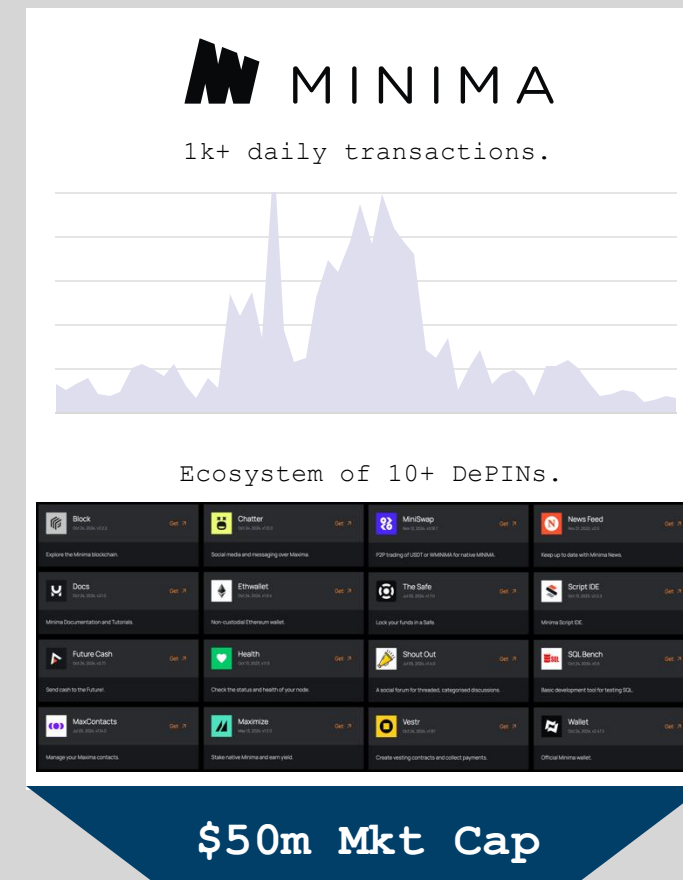
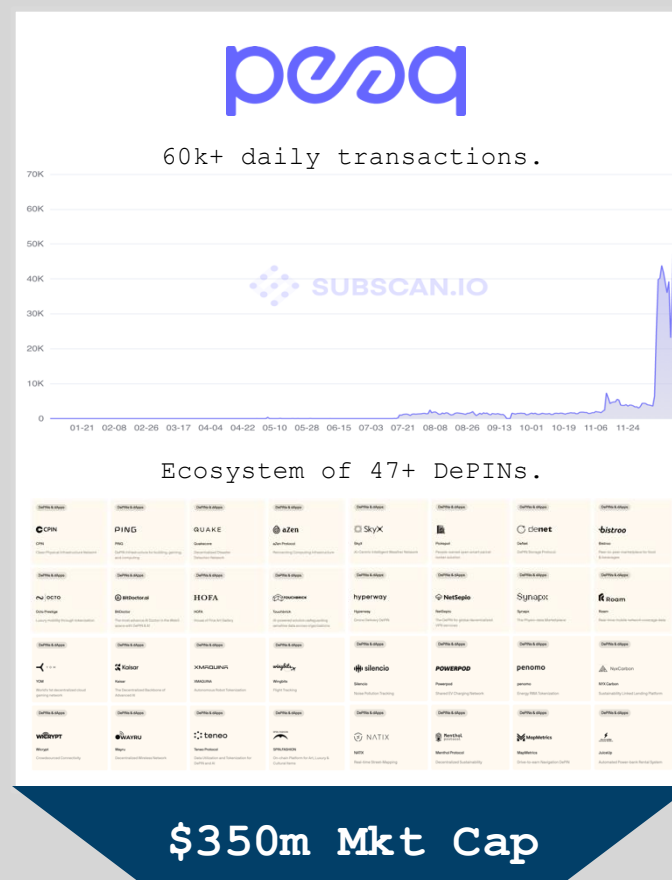
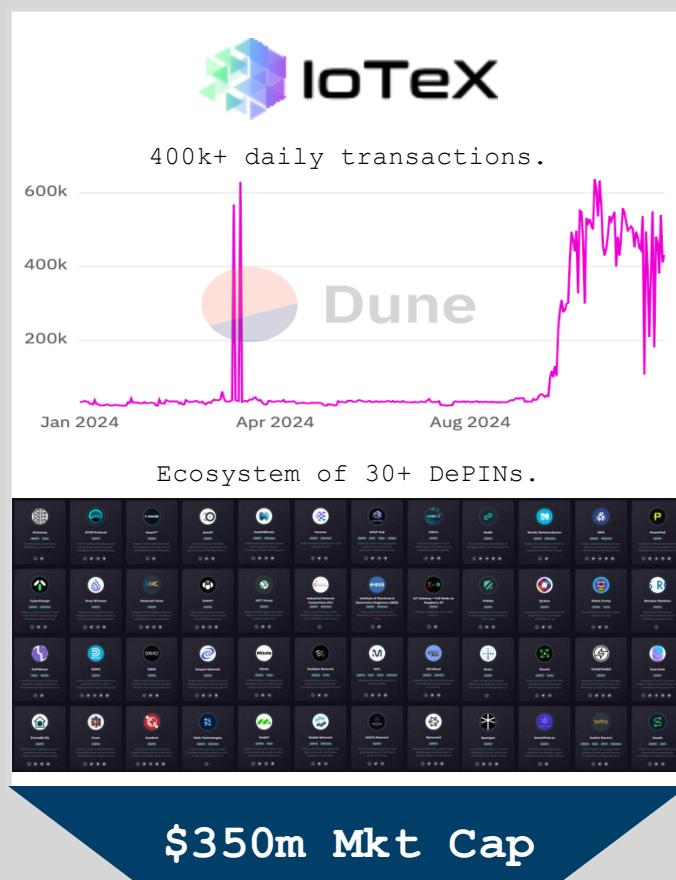

Dedicated L1s-for-DePIN are carving out their own native onchain ecosystems.

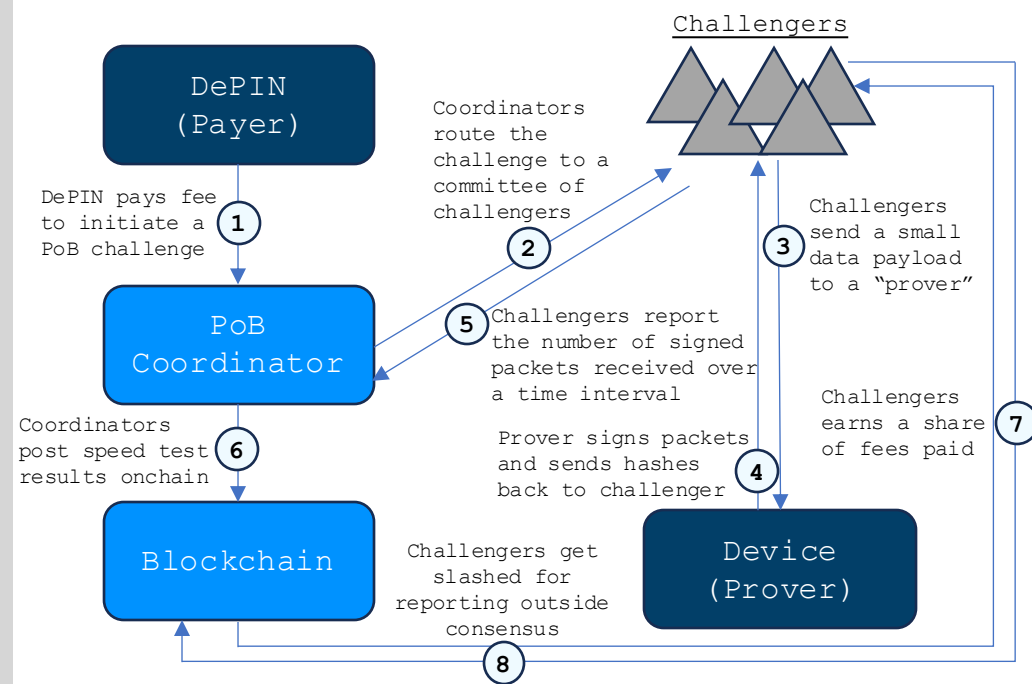
The most mature DePIN L1 ecosystem, **IoTeX**, grew onchain transaction activity by 10x+ in Q4'24, while two up-and-coming challengers, Peaq & Minima, launched mainnet tokens.



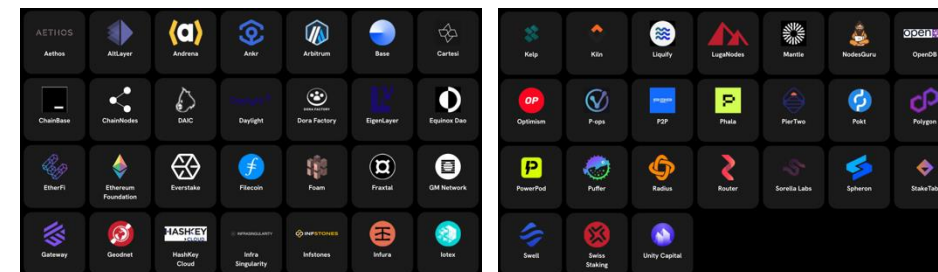
Primitives like proof-of-location & backhaul are making DePINs easier to scale.

Witness Chain launched the first general-purpose proof-of-location protocol on testnet, secured by \$14B+ in re-staked ETH via Eigenlayer.

Proof-of-location works similarly to proof-of-bandwidth, using round-trip ping times and the speed of light to triangulate a location for any internet-connected device.

DePIN Sensors are becoming cheaper, more diverse & more powerful than in the past.

Now that DePINs have a **playbook for reaching 10k+ active nodes**, contract manufacturers are willing to work with founders on custom hardware development.

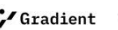
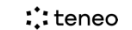

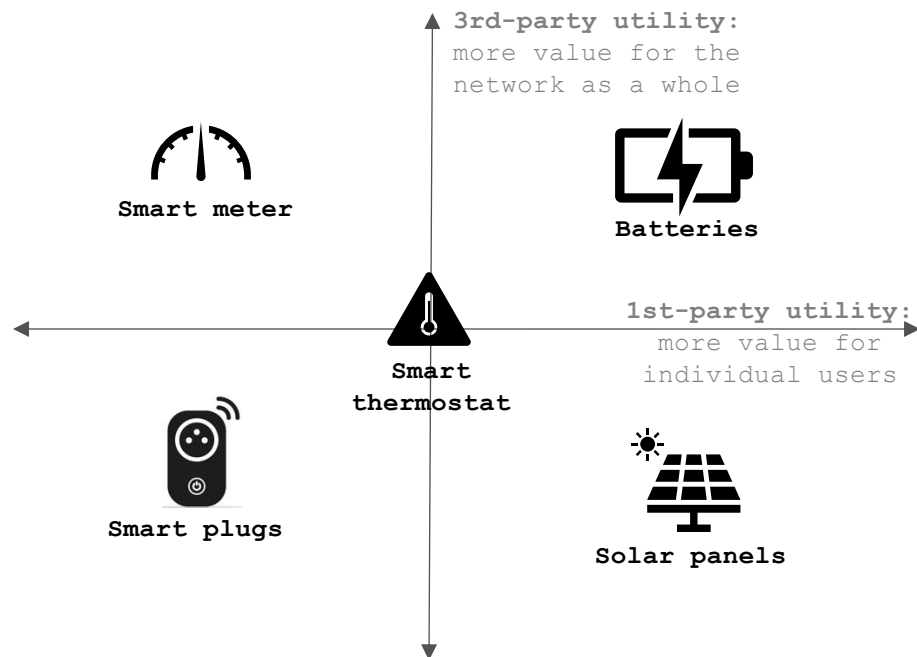

The best hardware form factors drive “come for the tool, stay for the network” behavior.

Network effects are strongest when nodes provide **both 1st-party utility for the individual miner & 3rd-party utility** for other users on the network.

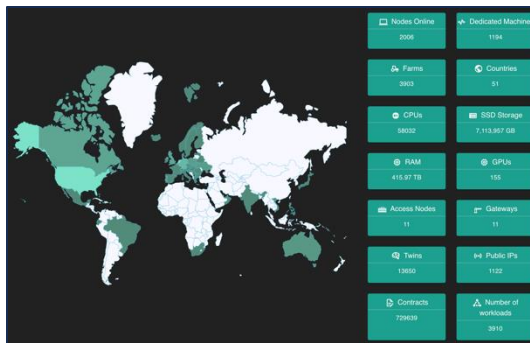

Local governments are looking to DePIN to address infrastructure challenges.

Public officials are using DePIN to advance issues that matter to voters & win elections, from ensuring AI sovereignty in Tanzania to shrinking the digital divide in Mexico.



- Threefold, a full-stack decentralized computing network, partnered with the Tanzanian government to create a *sovereign economic area* in the island of Zanzibar.
- The area, [OurWorld Free Zone](#), runs sovereign digital identity, tax, licensing, banking and other critical services on local computing infrastructure, rather than renting servers from European or Asian providers.

- Gane, a Mexican MVNO, offers free/low-cost cell phone plans, subsidized by rewards paid for in-app activities like completing surveys, trying new products or services, mapping locations, labeling data, watching ads, etc.

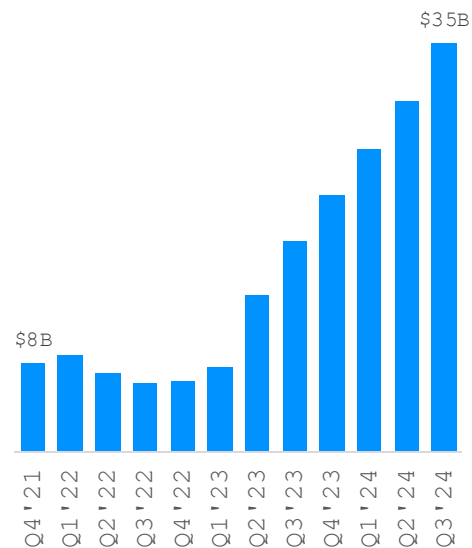


In 2024, the world realized the scale of AI's voracious appetite for digital commodities.

With a handful of tech giants racing to secure control over critical AI resources, DePIN is the rest of the world's only hope to have a seat at the table.

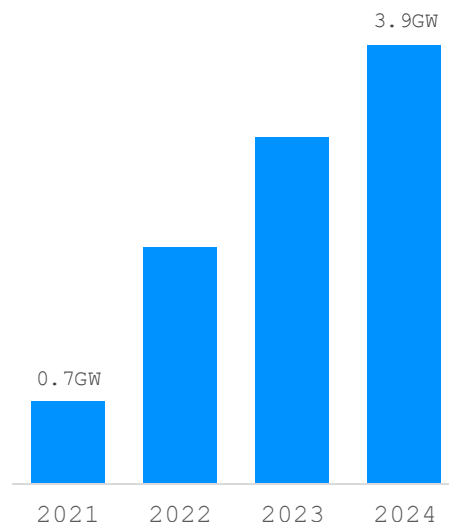

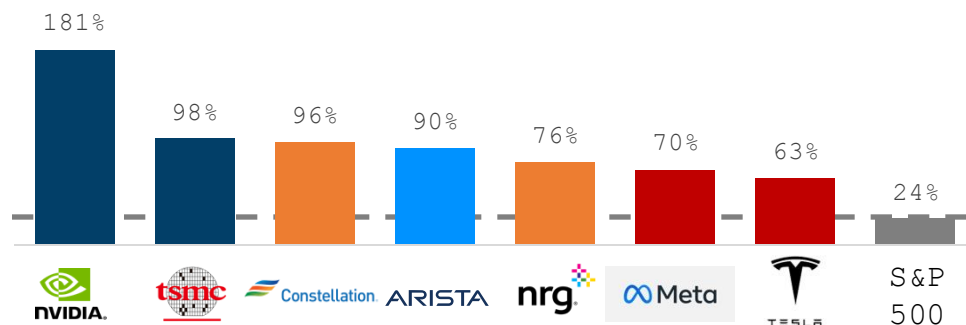


If you had early conviction in AI, onchain agents were the most convex bet to make.

Unlike public equity markets which look through to the underlying resources constraining AI growth, **demand for AI tokens cannibalized demand for DePIN tokens in 2024.**

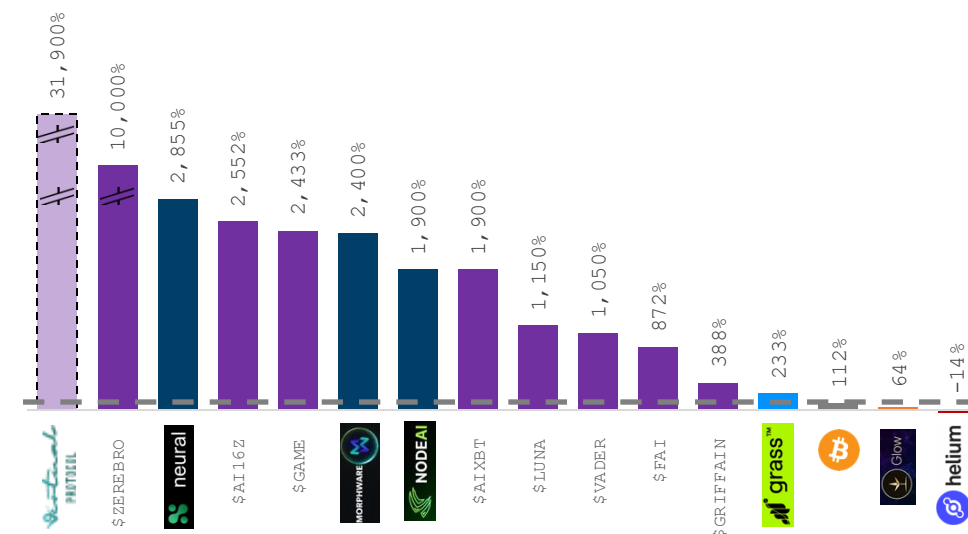
FY24 Returns: AI Equities

While direct AI infra - chip manufacturers - were the year's best performers in equity markets, indirect AI infra - energy & networking - also did extremely well relative to the index.



FY24 Returns: AI Agents

Agents beat infra as the best trade of 2024, led by the leading platform for launching agents: Virtuals. Unlike in public equity markets, AI-driven repricing hasn't yet trickled down to energy & networking DePINs like it has in equities.

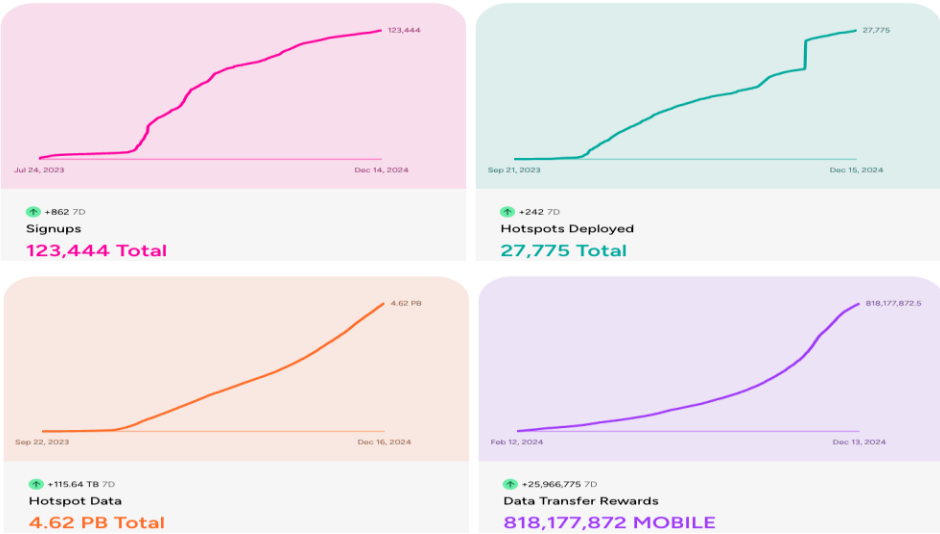


Consumers are ready for something new: 2024 was Helium Mobile's 0-to-1 moment.

Helium added >100k subscribers and >300k indirect users this year, bootstrapping two distinct business lines to seven-figures in annualized onchain net revenues.

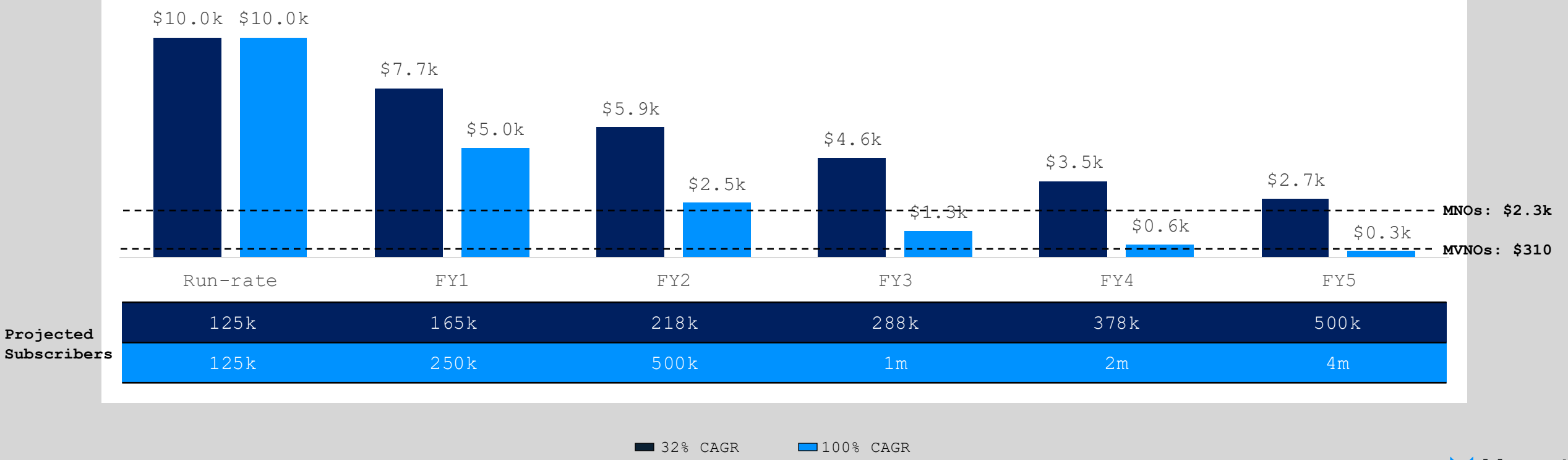

High-frequency spectrum.

In 2020, the FCC opened up the 6GHz band for unlicensed use, enabling independent ISPs to deliver high-speed home internet over spectrum that had previously been reserved for telcos.



Software-defined radios.

Starting around 2023, high-performance SDRs became powerful enough to provide gigabit-speed point-to-multipoint internet links from one transmitter to many receivers at once.



AI-driven networking.

Telcos are undergoing a fundamental change as big as the shift from analogue (1G) to digital (2G) as core network functions shift from being controlled by static software (5G) to being controlled by dynamic AIs (6G).

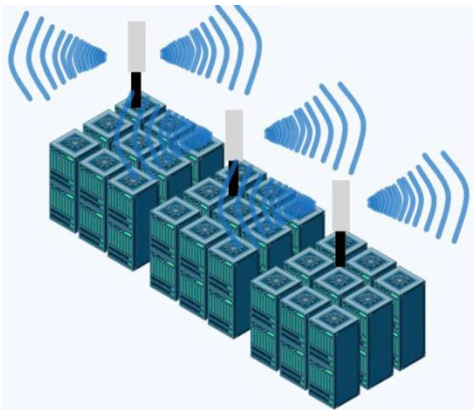

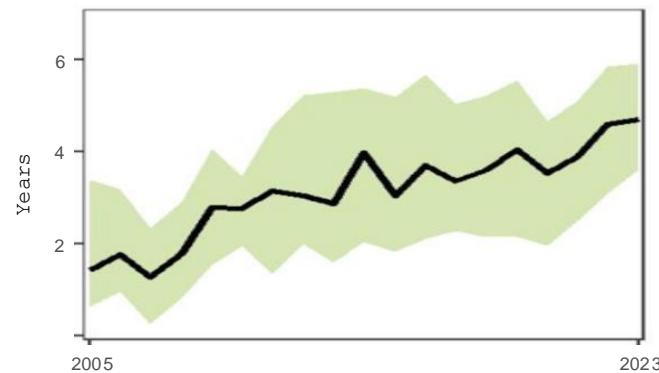

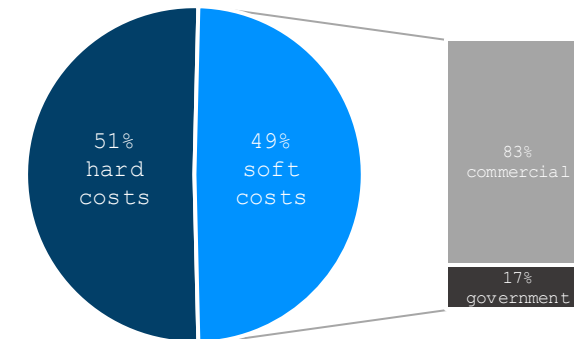

Daylight creates a decentralized energy flywheel through decentralized incentives.

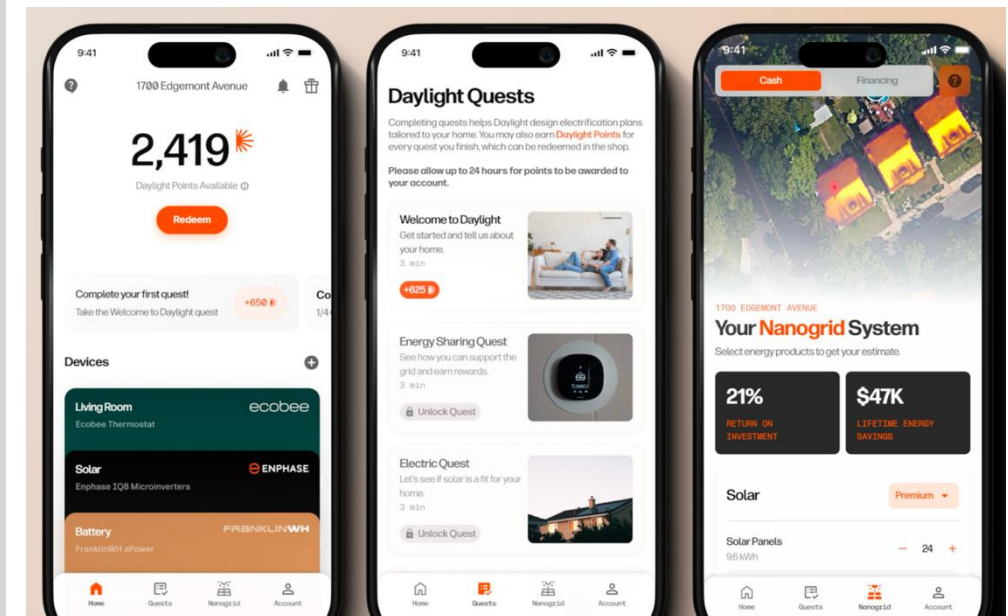
Daylight scales distributed energy by **incentivizing & coordinating across the energy entire stack**, from installation to financing to orchestration.

How it Works

Daylight's novel Proof-of-Flexibility (PoF) consensus mechanism rewards smart energy devices with \$GRID for committing to providing flexible energy capacity to the grid in the future; energy companies redeem \$GRID for access to the network's flexible energy capacity.



Mobile App



\$GRID is the first energy-backed currency touching every part of the energy value chain.

\$GRID is the **settlement & consensus layer** for physical and financial distributed energy markets, using staking & burns to back a currency supported by a \$1T/yr TAM in the US.

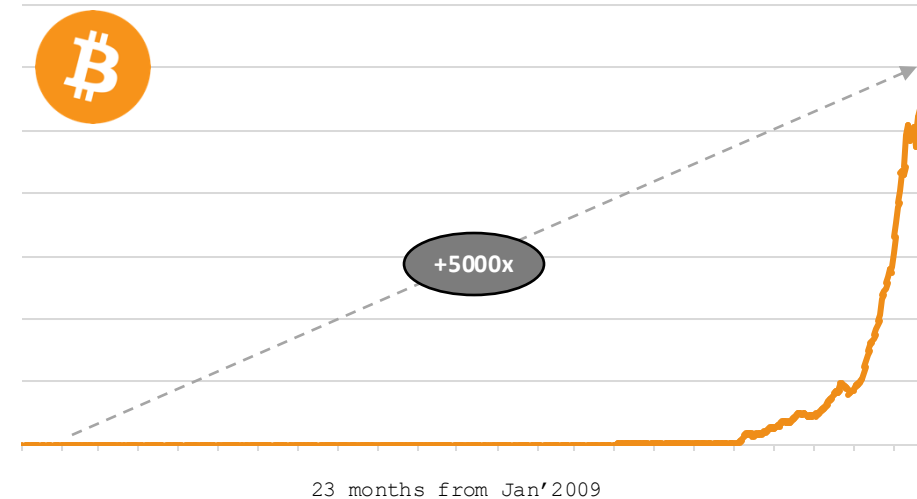

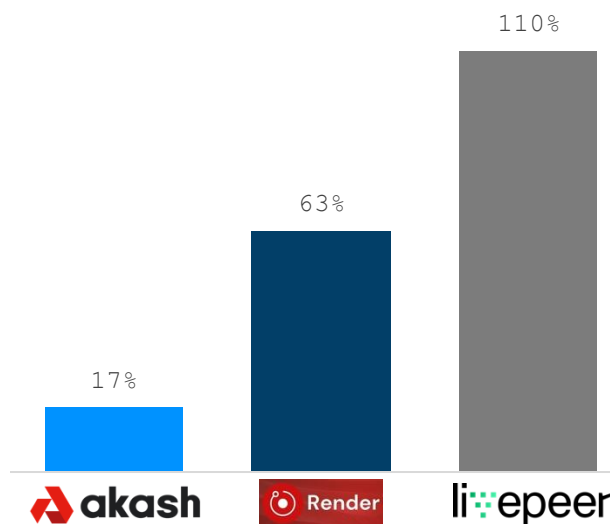

As the returns to scale on compute starts to taper off, AI researchers are turning their attention to **data bottlenecks** to drive continued improvements in model performance.

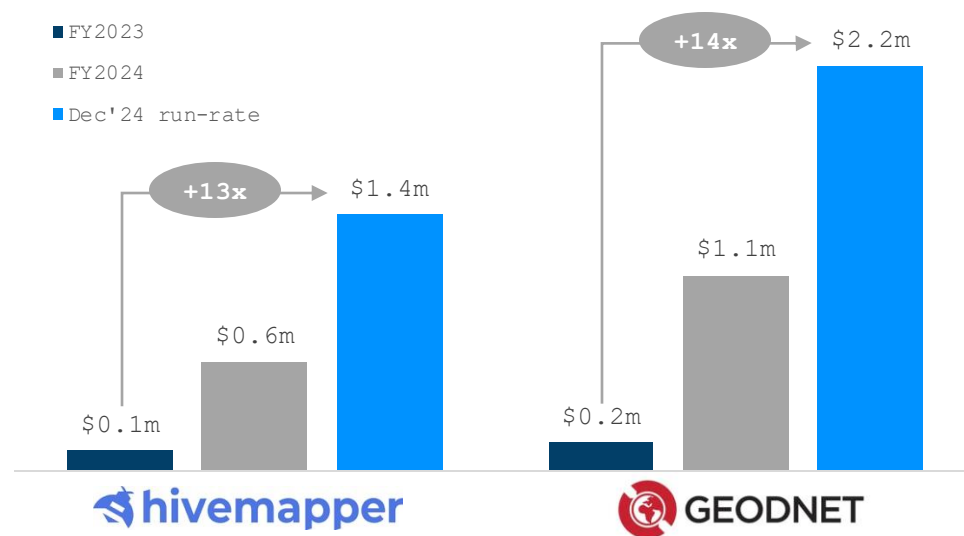


Sensor DePINs generated \$1.7M revenue in 2024 (+500% YoY) with a massive acceleration in Q4.

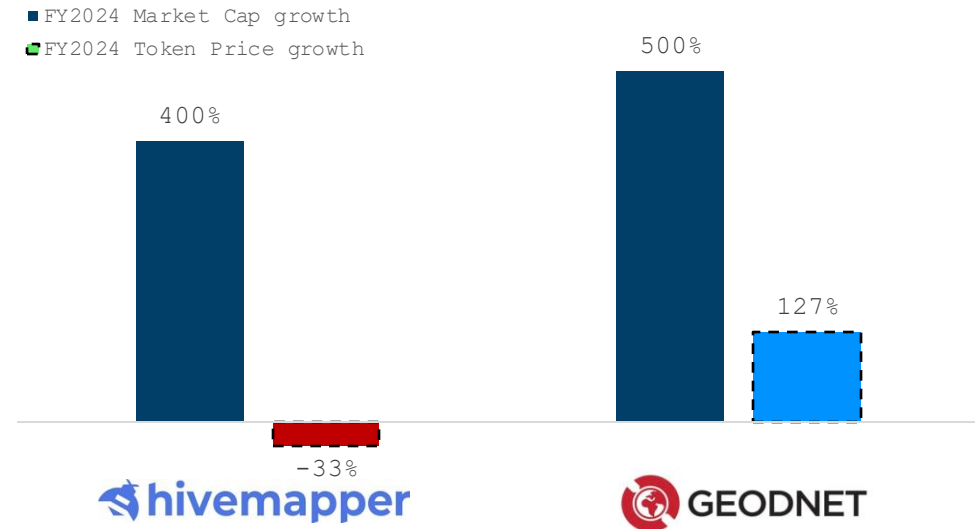

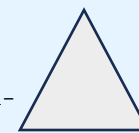

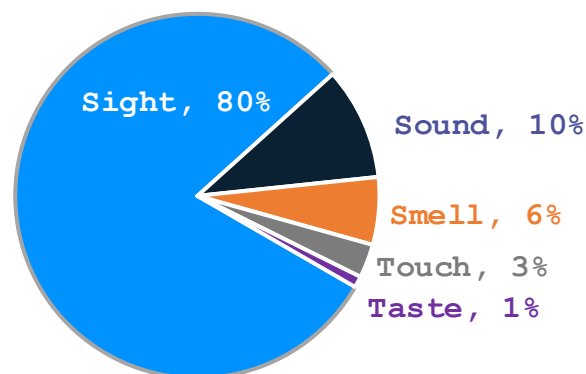

Cameras are the **King of Sensors**: they enable an extremely diverse set of emerging use cases across robotics, AI, autonomous vehicles, augmented/virtual reality & more.

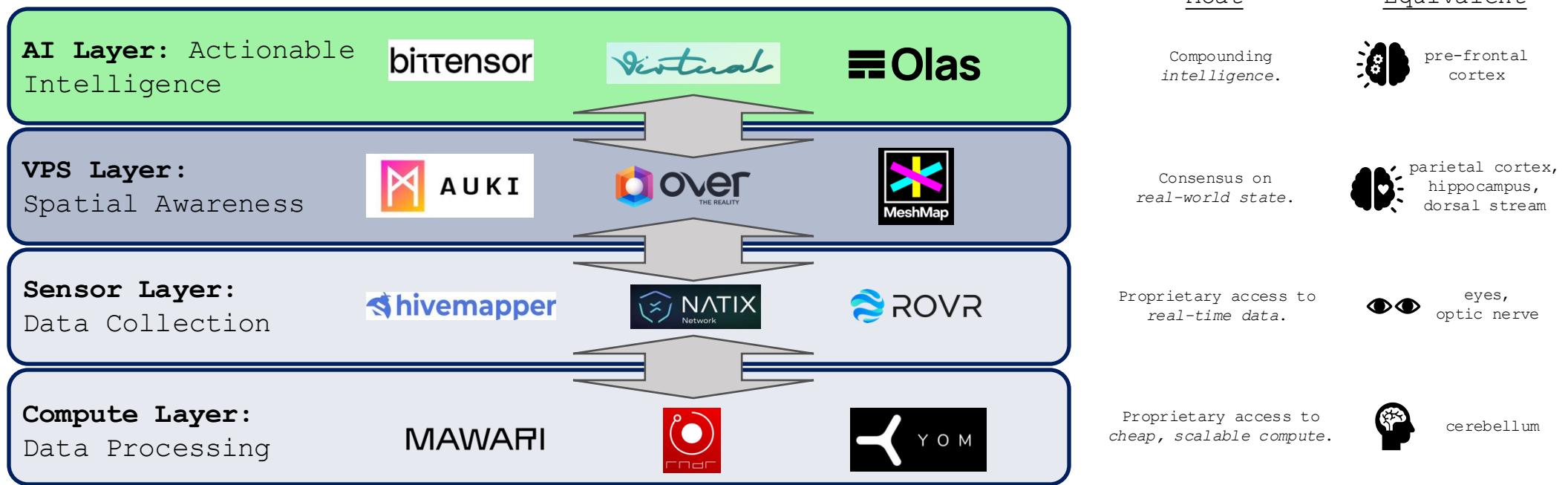

Positioning DePINs serve narrower use cases than cameras, with steeper tradeoffs.

Positioning networks can drive **trillions of dollars of downstream value for customers**, but face stiff competition amongst each other and against visual positioning systems.

Identity verification is a core problem limiting crypto's most promising use cases.

The growth of India Stack suggests that a **credibly-neutral digital identity layer** is a prerequisite for mass adoption of digital payments & other real-world use cases.

India Stack's Growth

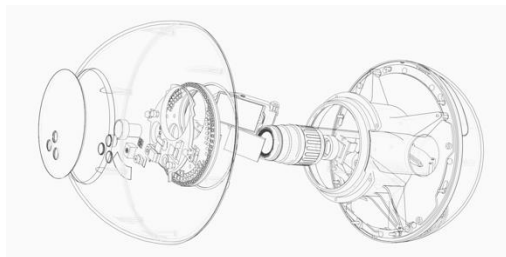


This cycle's "Samcoin" is the undisputed leader in verifiable human identity.

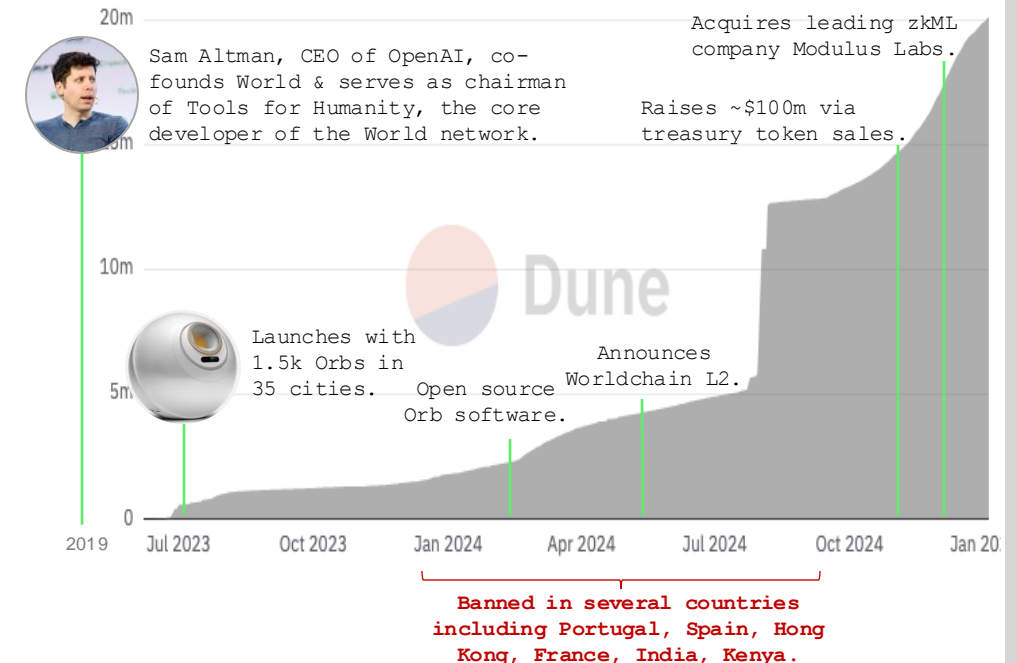
Despite bans in several major countries, World (fka Worldcoin) grew to **>20m verified identities in its first eighteen months** & commands a fully-diluted valuation of **>\$20B**.

How it Works

- 1 Users scan their iris with a specialized high-resolution (visual & infra-red) camera called an Orb.
- 2 The Orb hashes an image of the iris on local compute & deletes the image after hashing to ensure user privacy.
- 3 The hash is compared to a global list of hashes to check for duplicates, generating a proof-of-humanity.
- 4 Both the Orb operator and the end-user earn \$WLD rewards for every new unique/verified human identity.



Network Growth



Worldcoin's success is driving innovation in competing proof-of-personhood protocols.

Proof-of-personhood solutions compete on **two sets of overlapping tradeoffs**:
scanning *accuracy vs cost* & identifier *persistence vs privacy*.

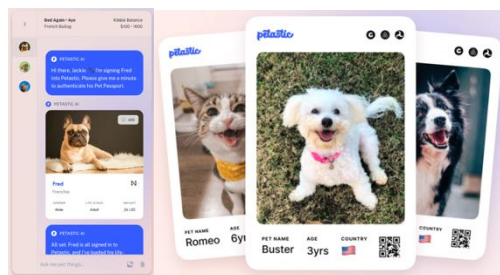
Humans aren't the only ones that need digital identities: Anymal tracks >1.5m pets onchain.

By **partnering directly with shelters & rescues**, Petastic - the first app on the Anymal protocol - has onboard millions of pets before its public launch.

How it Works

Animal shelters & rescues partner with Petastic to automate the pet adoption funnel: pet parents simply download the Petastic app and have access to all of their pet's records.

Within Petastic's app, users get access to an AI-powered pet concierge that can access every relevant detail of the pet's identity, without users ever giving up control over their data.

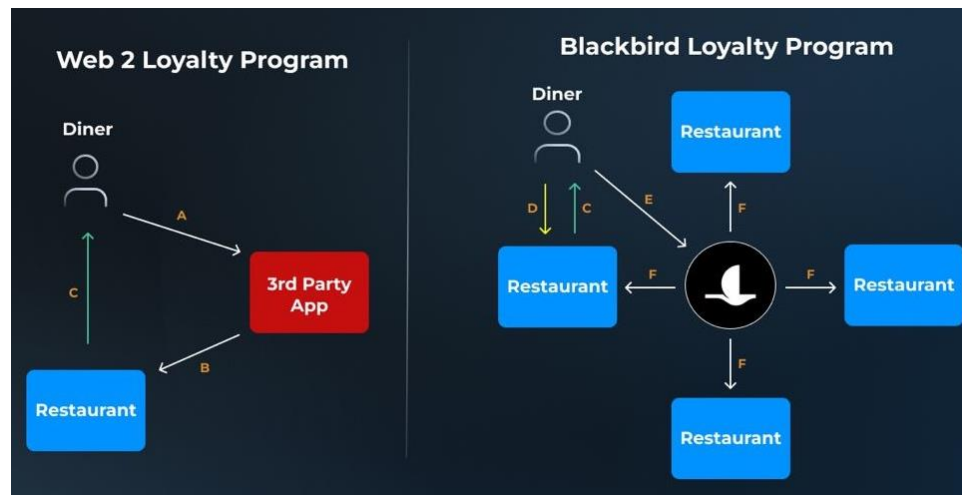
Dimo's ecosystem scaled **meaningfully in terms of supply-side scale and developer activity in 2024**, while onchain revenues ended the year roughly flat at ~\$10k ARR.



Decentralized loyalty & rewards networks create value through “vertical identity”.

Co-founded by Resy founder Ben Leventhal, Blackbird raised \$35m from a16z, Multicoin & USV and saw **users check-in to partner restaurants 75k+ times** in the first nine months.

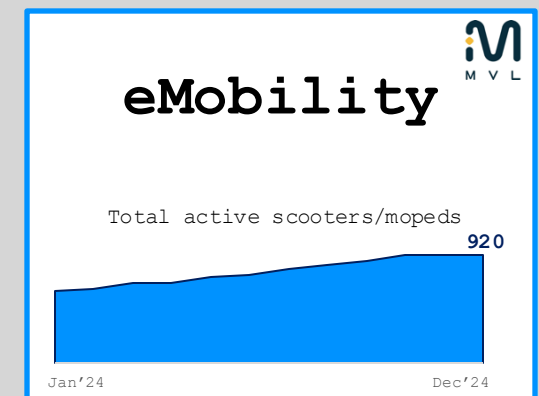
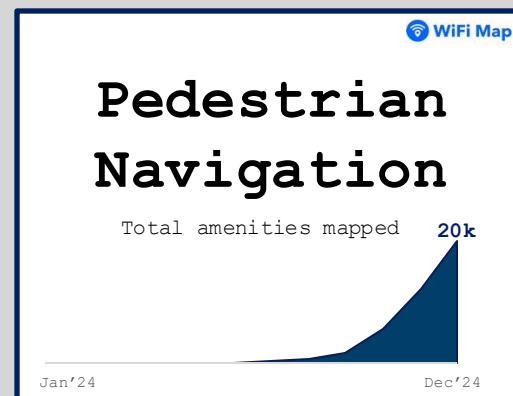
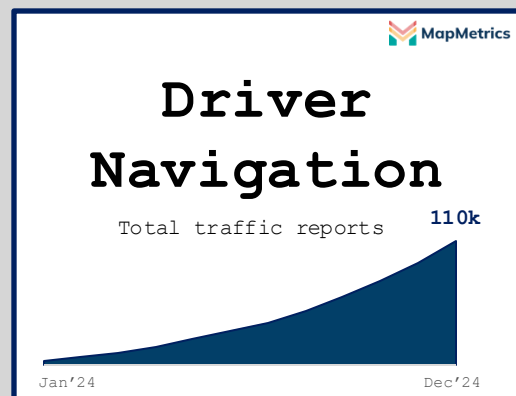
Logistics DePINs move people and/or things from one location to another.

Logistics is the **most nascent category of DePIN**, with entrepreneurs experimenting with onchain incentives at every corner of the \$5T+ global logistics industry.

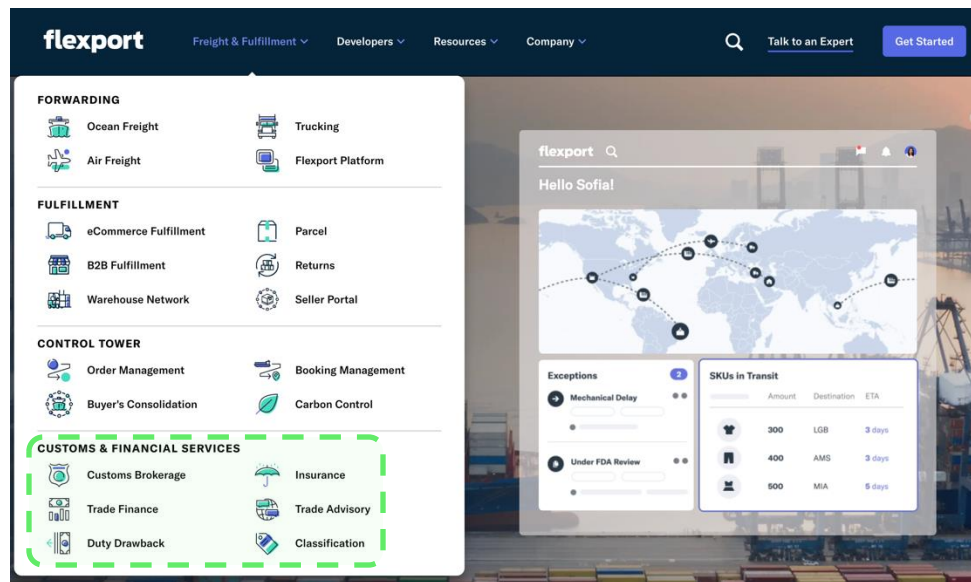

Logistics & finance are already intertwined: DePIN takes financialization one step further.

Digitization has driven value in the logistics supply chain **from infrastructure to capital** over the past decade as software platforms embedded native financial products.

Logistics x Financing Opportunities



Logistics x Financing Challenges

- Utilization:** 20-35% of truck miles driven are empty shipments.
- Theft:** \$35B of cargo gets stolen each year in the US.
- Fraud:** \$1B lost annually in payments to fraudulent brokers in the US.
- Settlement:** 6% of freight invoices contain billing errors.

Logistics DePINs use open hardware & software to track movement more efficiently than web2.

DePINs use **onchain capital to insure real-world activity** by leveraging cryptographically verified data from physical sensors & third-party software platforms.

DePINs like Teleport (rideshare) use smartphone geolocation data to validate mobility services rendered by human operators.

DePINs like 3DOS (manufacturing) use cameras inside 3D printers to validate the quality and timeliness of goods produced.

DePIN like Nodle (tracking) enable any device with a low-cost BLE tracker to be tracked by nearby Bluetooth-enabled devices, including smartphones.

DePINs like Nosh (food delivery) tap into web2 competitors' identity graphs to provide outsized incentives to the most valuable drivers.

DePINs like Dtravel (short-term rentals) tap into web2 incumbents' inventory management software to validate availability & settlement.

zkTLS











Networks like Opacity provide the cryptography infrastructure for third-parties to permissionlessly verify user offchain attributes/identities.

3-sided networks are the biggest & most defensible opportunities in logistics.

Three-sided networks tend to dominate the largest global markets, where **onchain capital** can be used to provide better financing for bootstrapping marketplace activity.

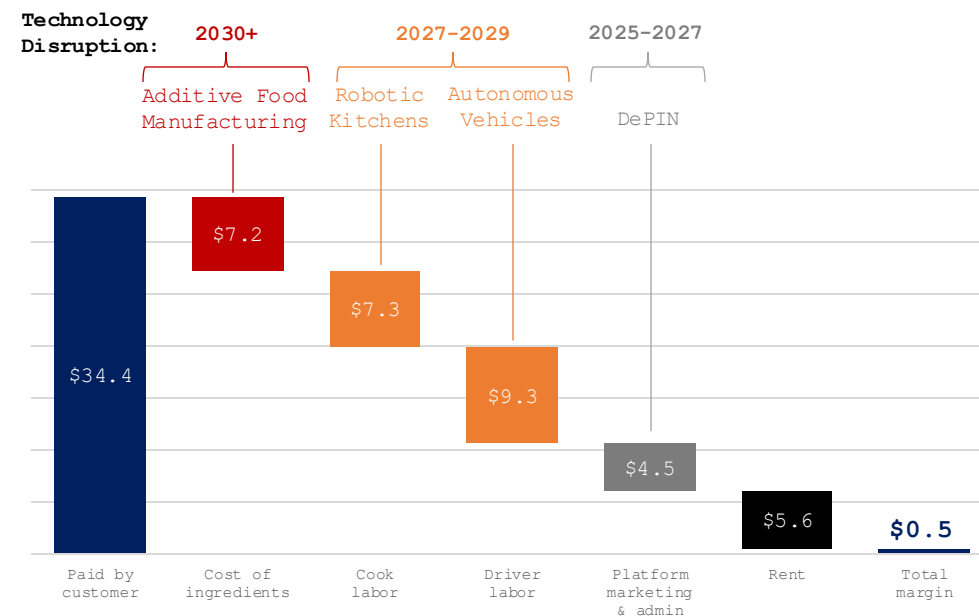

By empowering local restaurants to recruit their own drivers, Nosh has the potential to **increase margins in the food delivery business from \$0.50 to \$5.00 per order.**

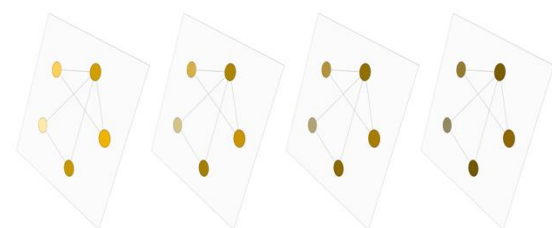

Nosh is powered by LOCAL, the first fully-generalizable DePIN consensus protocol.

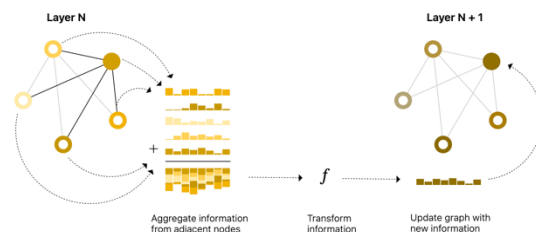
Like Google's PageRank algorithm, LOCAL is **agnostic to the nature of economic activity** on the protocol and will therefore eventually expand to every locally-rendered service.

Protocol Mechanics



Market participants are represented as nodes in a transaction graph, with edge weights corresponding to the cumulative in-protocol transaction fees between each pair.

Inspired by Google's PageRank algorithm, the protocol distributes \$LOCAL rewards to nodes based on their eigenvector centrality, cleverly mitigating sybil & self-dealing attacks that plague DePIN today.



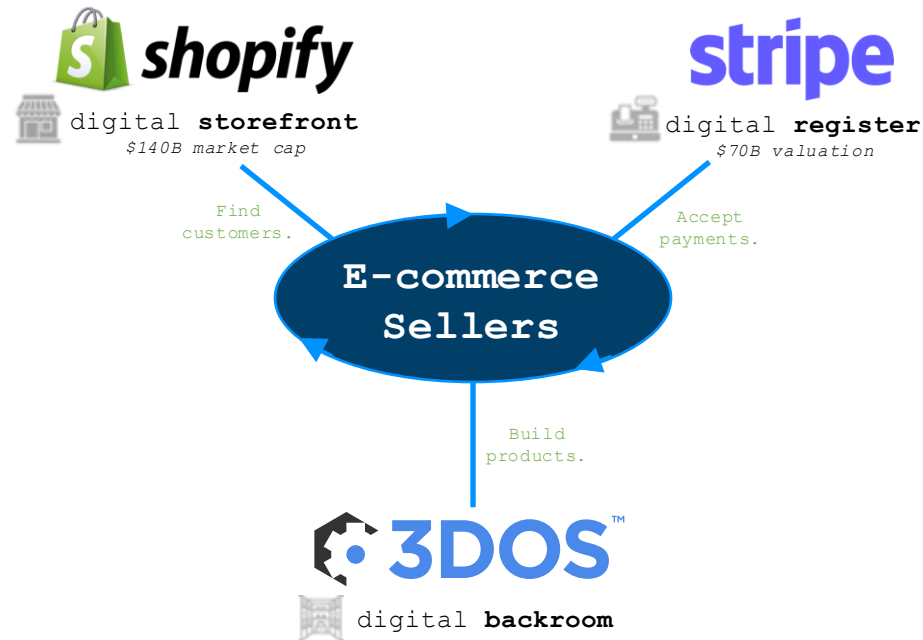

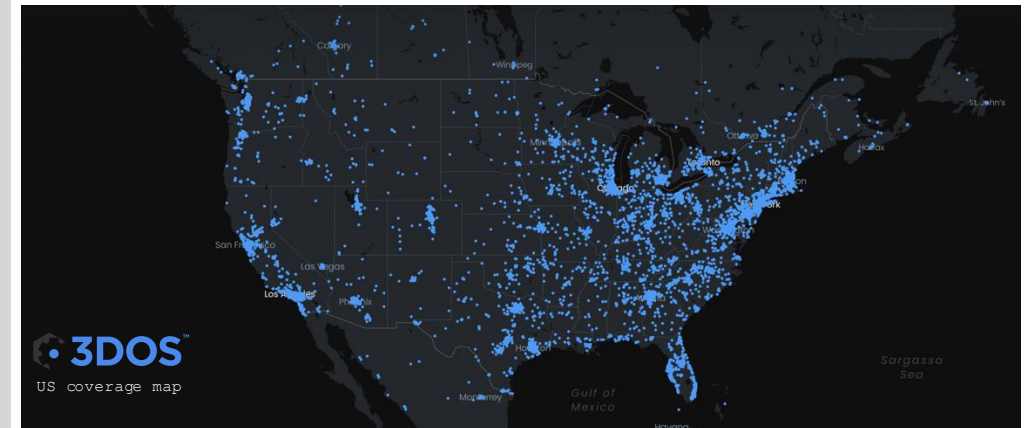
3DOS is building the missing pillar of e-commerce: on-demand manufacturing.

Dtravel’s tokenization protocol gives hosts end-to-end control over their listing, regardless of which platform consumers use to make the booking.

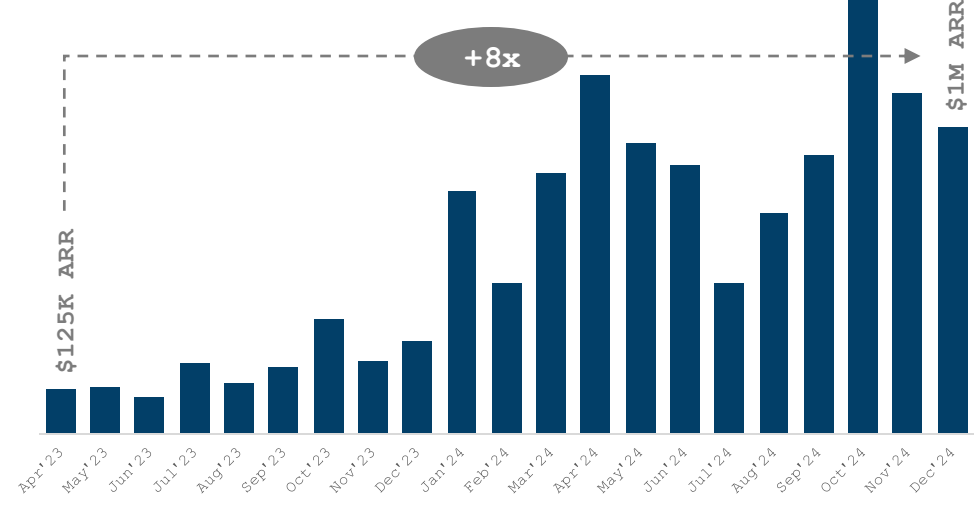

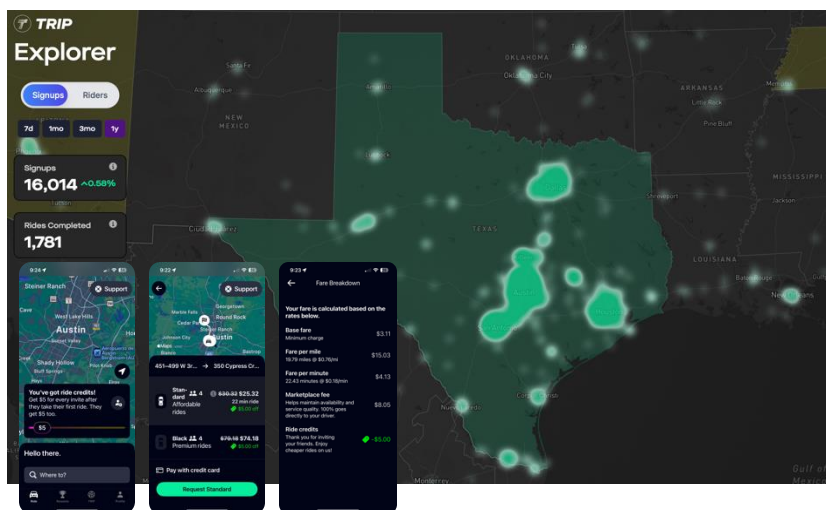


Teleport is disrupting the ride-sharing industry starting with Austin, Texas.

With ridesharing platforms like Uber taking **up to 45% of fares**, both riders & drivers are hungry for ridesharing networks that put their interests first.

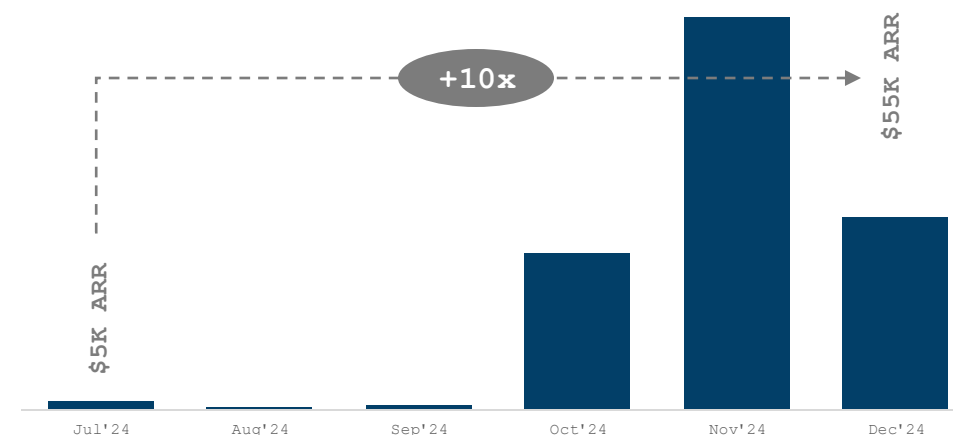

Network Growth

In the first two quarters post-launch, Teleport's booking platform has grown by >10x to over fifty thousand dollars in annualized gross revenues.



There are several unexplored billion-dollar DePIN logistics opportunities remaining.

Looking to web2 startups for inspiration, there is demand for **new forms of logistics networks bootstrapped by novel use cases** like luggage storage & short-term staffing.

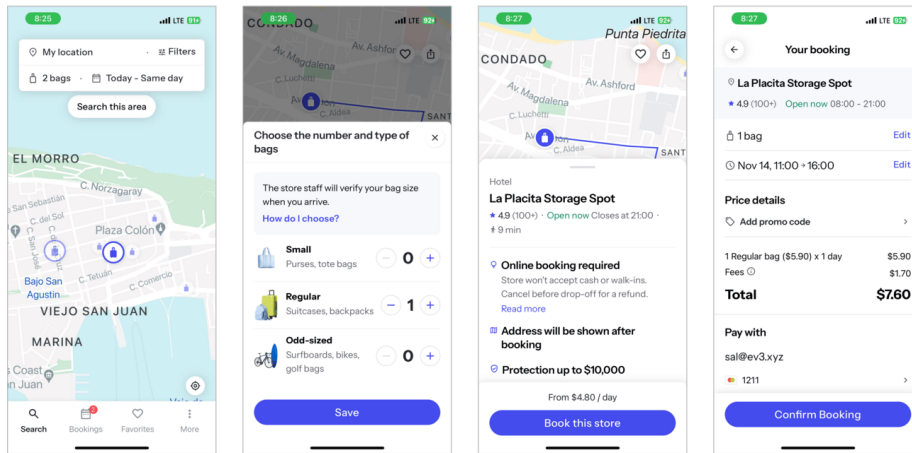


Luggage Storage

Bounce connects travelers with local shops to store their luggage for the day, backed by a \$5k insurance-like policy.

Bounce has grown by >750x over the past four years and is currently available at 13k+ locations worldwide.

Staffing

Timee is a Japanese on-demand staffing startup for the hospitality, retail, events, nursing, childcare and manufacturing sectors.

Grew net revenues +67% in 2024 up to ~\$170m ARR, with only 1 million of Japan's 7-10 million gig workers onboarded onto the platform.

Raised \$350m in Japan's largest IPO of 2024, currently valued at \$1B.
